Introduction

Rufaidah bint Sa'ad ورض النتان بها is recognized as the first Muslim nurse. Her full name was Rufaidah bint Sa'ad of the Bani Aslam tribe of the Khazraj tribal confederation in Madinah. She was born in Yathrib before the migration of the Prophet Muhammad صلى . She was among the first people in Madinah to accept Islam and was one of the Ansar women who welcomed the Prophet on arrival in Madinah.

Rufaidah's father was a physician. She learned medical care by working as his assistant. Her history illustrates all the attributes expected of a good nurse. She was kind and empathetic and a capable leader, who organized, mobilized and got others to produce good work. She had clinical skills that she shared with other nurses whom she trained and worked with; she did not confine her nursing to the clinical situation. She went out to the community and tried to solve the social problems that lead to disease. She was both a public health nurse and a social worker.

The purpose of establishing Rufaidah Nursing College was laid upon the foundation of nursing during the Islamic era of Prophet Mohammad، صلى الله عليه وسلم RNC is situated within the premises of Kuwait Teaching hospital which is located at the Abdara Chowk, University Road Peshawar.

Admission/Selection Criteria and Process

Candidates are supposed to fill the form before the deadline and submit it along with all attested documents required for the position they are applying. Application/ form incomplete or received after the due date will not be entertained. In case of false documents or fabricated information found at any stage, Nursing College has the right to cancel the admission. Selection of the candidates will be purely on merit.

Pre-requisites for Post RN B.Sc. Nursing (2 Years) Program:

- 1. Diploma in General Nursing registered with Pakistan Nursing Council (candidates with 1st division will be preferred)
- 2. Diploma in Midwifery for female applicants
- 3. Diploma in any specialty for male applicants
- Candidate must have a minimum of two years clinical experience after Nursing Diploma

Pre-requisites for BSc Nursing (4 Years) Program:

- 1. Candidate must have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (F.sc or equivalent qualification from a recognized board)
- 2. Age limit 18 to 35 years
- Candidates with a bachelor or equivalent degree in science subjects will be preferred

Hostel

Hostel facility is available for female students on payment basis (as per actual).

College Rules

- Every part of the College and hostel premises must be kept clean and should not be damaged in any way or form.
- 2. Student must observe discipline in the class and during the clinical hours.
- 3. Students are strictly required to be punctual in attending class as well as in their hospital duties.
- 4. Students are not allowed to leave lecture hall or hospital without the permission of the teacher.
- 5. In case of leave, the student must apply in writing with the reason for leave. Every student must have at least 85% attendance at the end of the each semester of education. Students will not be allowed to appear in semester / annual exam with attendance less than 85%. Repeated absence from classes and hospital duties will make a student liable to expulsion from the College.
- 6. No student will be allowed to take the examination unless he/she clear all the dues.
- 7. Political activities are strictly forbidden in the College, hostel, and hospital or in any forum which is associated with the college. In case of involvement the disciplinary committee will take serious action.
- 8. Socially unacceptable activities (gambling/use of narcotics/possession of arms/objectionable literature etc.) within the premises of College, hospital and hostel are strictly prohibited. Shouting, or making noises or singing in premises are not allowed and are contrary to decent behavior and conduct expected of the students.
- 9. Students are not allowed to indulge in foul languages, physical jokes or bullying/fighting.
- 10. It is not allowed to bring outsiders to lecture halls and hostel without the written permission.
- 11. All accidents minor and major must be reported to the college authorities.
- 12. Student are not allowed to enter College and Hospital without identity badge and overall.
- 13. Any other rules notified by the administration from time to time
