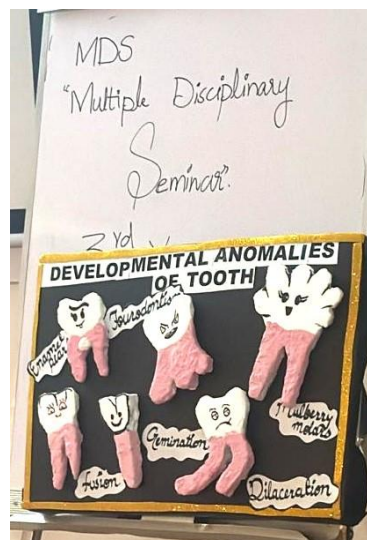
This initiative demonstrates the colleges' strong sense of social responsibility and the lasting impact of collaborative efforts in alleviating human suffering.

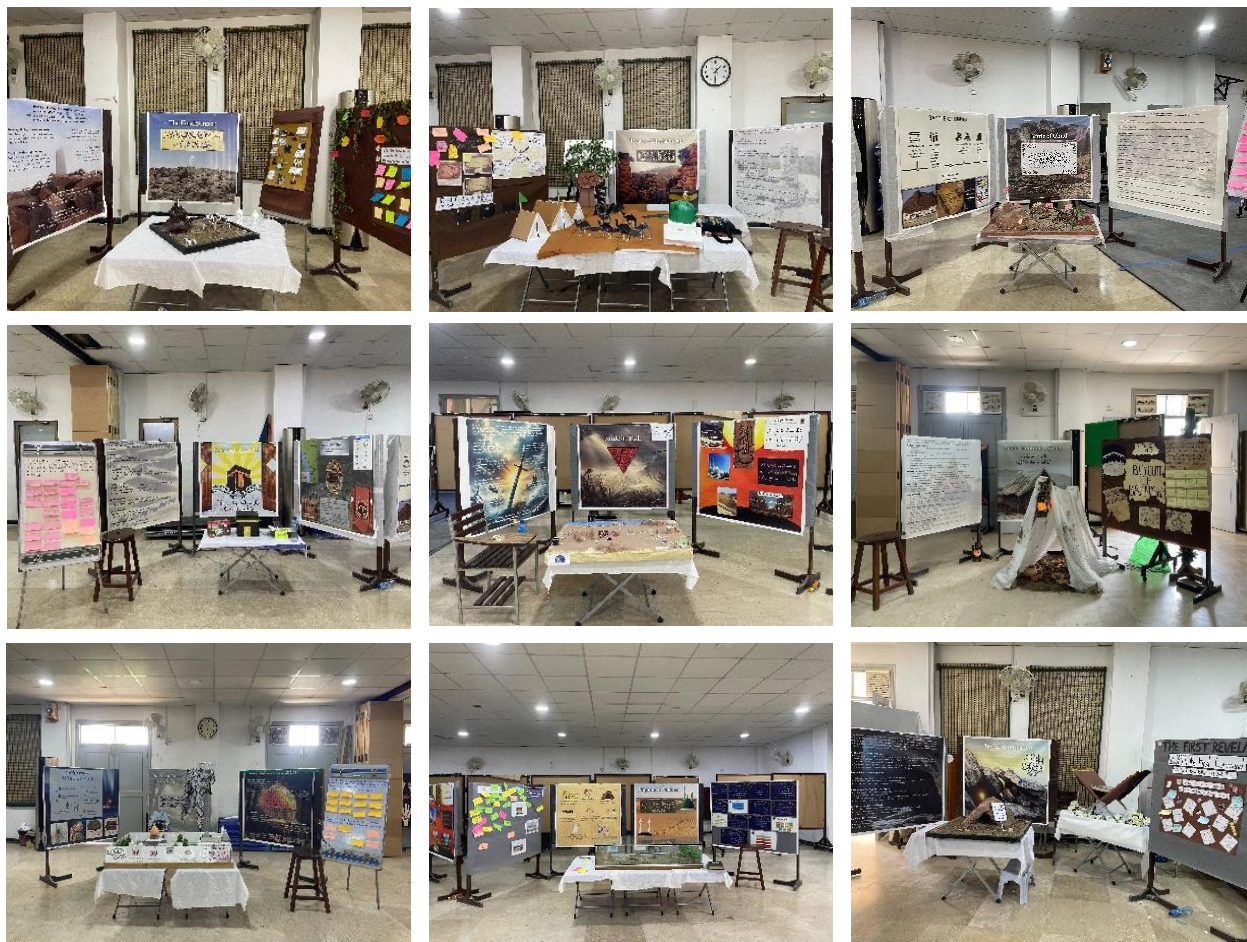
Seerat Exhibition 2025 at PMC at PMC
