
Hospital was deemed a successful exercise, reinforcing the hospital's commitment to ensuring the safety and well-being of its patients, staff, and visitors.





Undergraduate Medical Research (UMR) Program, PMC

The Undergraduate Medical Research (UMR) program at Peshawar Medical College was launched in 2006 with the admission of the first MBBS batch. Students were introduced to fundamental medical research principles through structured lectures and hands-on training. The program's success was highlighted by the First Annual Undergraduate Medical Research Conference in 2007. Since then, the UMR program has organized 17 successful conferences, continuing its legacy of fostering research skills among medical, dental, and nursing students.



The UMR department introduces students to research by teaching them the basics and providing guidance throughout the research process, helping to transform their ideas into successful projects. Third-year MBBS and second-year BDS students undergo a UMR rotation, which focuses on research ethics, skills, and development. proposal Qualified faculty from basic, clinical, and social sciences supervise student research, including approval from the Ethical Review Committee of Peshawar Medical College.

Additionally, the department facilitates student participation in external research conferences, where they have earned awards in national and international verbal presentations, poster exhibitions, and quiz competitions.

The UMR department has successfully organized 17 research conferences, attracting participants from across Pakistan who submit their research abstracts. Participation has increased each year, with students showing greater motivation to engage in research and actively participate in the conferences.

Future Plans of the UMR Department:

The UMR department plans to organize the 18th UMR Conference in 2025, with the aim of expanding it to an international level by inviting global institutes. Preparations will also be made for the UMR rotation for the new cohort of third-year MBBS and second-year BDS students. Furthermore, the department will ensure that UMR researchers receive the necessary support to successfully and timely execute their research projects.
