This victory further solidifies Peshawar Medical College's reputation for nurturing talent and promoting research-driven education.




DAAD Honors Dr. Hala Rajab for Key Research in Cancer Metabolic Pathways

Dr. Hala Rajab, Assistant Professor of Molecular Biology and Director of Undergraduate Medical Research at Peshawar Medical & Dental College, has been awarded the prestigious 'Re-invitation Programme for DAAD Alumni' grant from the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD)!

Dr. Rajab previously completed a short-term postdoctoral research fellowship at the renowned German Cancer Research Center (DKFZ) in Heidelberg, Germany, from July to September 2024. She worked under the mentorship of the distinguished Professor Dr. Christiane Opitz, Head of the Division of Metabolic Crosstalk in Cancer.

Her research focused on exploring the metabolic pathway that governs the production of Kynurenic acid from Kynurenine, a key regulator of Aryl hydrocarbon receptor (AHR) activation, and its implications for immunity and cancer progression. Using pharmacological inhibition and knockdown techniques, Dr. Hala targeted Kynurenine aminotransferases human glioblastoma U-87



cell lines, investigating their effects on AHR signature expression.

This groundbreaking study paves the way for developing innovative strategies to inhibit key enzymes involved in AHR activity, potentially leading to novel therapeutic approaches to counteract cancer-related immunosuppression and tumor aggressiveness.

Ethical Decision-Making and Professional Integrity in Medicine: Workshop Held at Kuwait Teaching Hospital

World Heart Day Observed at Prime Teaching Hospital, Peshawar

The event concluded with a walk led by the Medical Superintendent of the hospital, Prof. Dr. Sardar Mohammad, to emphasize the importance of physical activity for a healthy heart. November 28,2024: At Sarhad University, lectures on diabetes prevalence and dietary strategies were delivered by Dr. Zaheer










Rufaidah Nursing College Hosts Student-Led Seminar Competition


