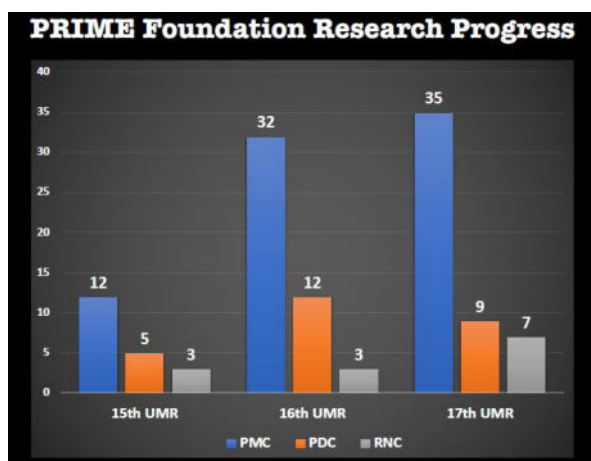

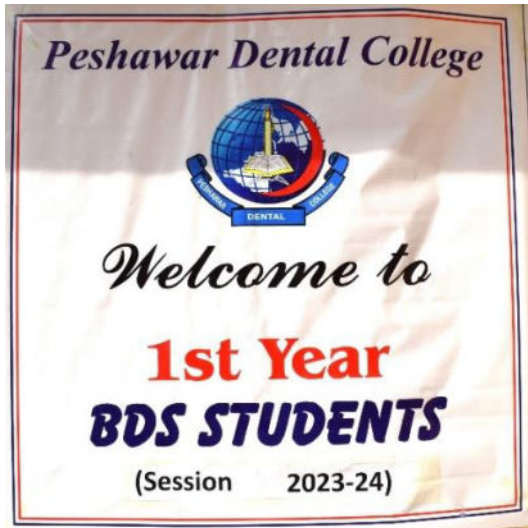

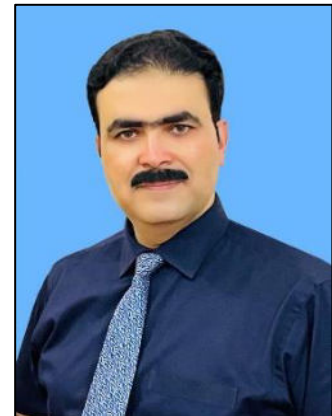

Analysis of Hamas Resistance and Current State of Palestine



Prof. Haneef analyzes the role of Hamas resistance, discussing its reasons and how it prepared people for resistance by instilling a sense of Jihad in Muslims. He examines the impact of Hamas resistance on differentiating true and false narratives among nations, exposing the double standards of human rights claims in the West. Furthermore, he evaluates the current state of Palestine, shedding light on the conspiracy behind the establishment of Israel and the settlement of Jews in the occupied area under the cover of the UK and the League of Nations. He highlights the injustices faced by Muslims, including atrocities, attacks, and restrictions on entry to Masjid Aqsa.

The author Rejects the stance that land of Palestine was bestowed to Jews argues that it was granted to believers and not to dynasty of bni Israeil , He cites evidences of the dislodging of Jews from Palestine in different phases of history and the control of Palestine by the second caliph Umar and later by Saladin. He criticizes the disproportionate distribution

of land between Jews and Muslims by the UN, ignoring the Muslim majority in the region. Additionally, Prof. Haneef exposes the roles of Russia, the USA, and the UK in supporting Israel and their involvement in the Palestine issue.

Hope for the Future and Critique of Muslim Rulers

The author f emphasizes the significance of Palestinian resistance as a means of survival, especially in the face of Gaza being turned into a besieged territory. He highlights the impact of Palestinians' bold struggle in attracting people to Islam, advocating for jihad as the way forward. The author criticizes Muslim rulers for their lack of support for the Palestinian cause, labeling their negligence as a crime. He foresees the potential for a large-scale war in Palestine and the eventual defeat of anti-Islamic forces, concluding with hope for a free Palestine and the defeat of oppressors.

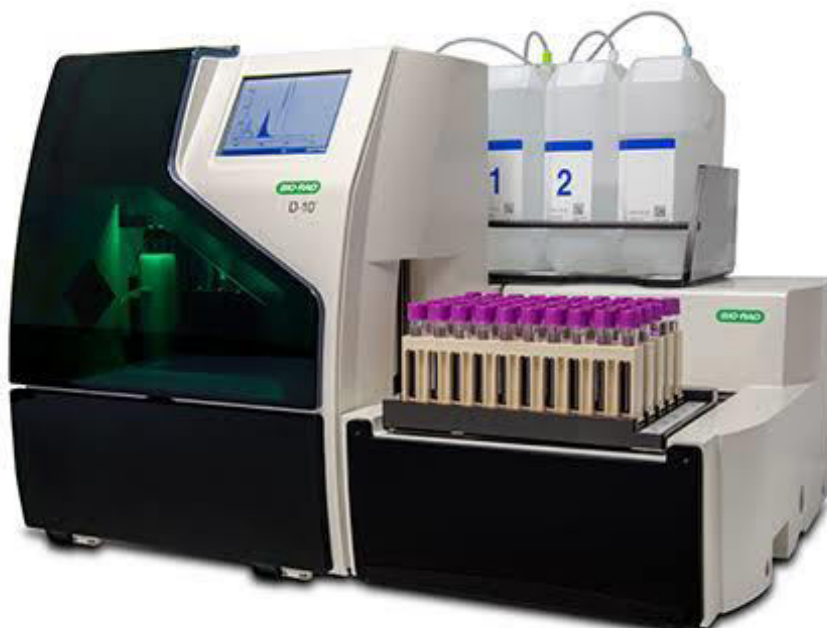

Faculty members, healthcare providers, and staff actively participated in the walk, symbolizing a poignant reminder of the

collective effort required to combat this global health challenge.

Following the walk, an engaging awareness session unfolded within the hospital premises. Dr. Bilal, an esteemed oncologist, delivered a comprehensive presentation covering various aspects of cancer. His insights illuminated the types of cancer, associated risk factors, and advancements in treatment modalities. Dr. Aakifullah, the Director of IRNUM Peshawar, complemented the session with a detailed talk focusing on preventive measures and the latest developments in cancer treatment.

Dr. Bilal took the stage to shed light on the global efforts and aims behind this crucial day, striving to promote research, prevent cancer, improve patient services, raise awareness, and mobilize the global community to make progress against cancer, as reflected in



the adoption of World Cancer Day. The staggering statistics revealed that 10 million people die each year from cancer, surpassing the combined numbers of deaths from HIV/AIDS, malaria, and tuberculosis, with projections indicating a rise to 13 million by 2030.

Dr. Bilal emphasized key messages, highlighting that more than one-



third of cancer can be prevented and detected early, with one-third being curable if treated properly. Knowledge was emphasized as power, as understanding cancer facilitates progress in reducing risk factors, increasing prevention, and improving cancer diagnosis, treatment, and care. Notably, 65% of cancer deaths currently occur in the least developed parts of the world.

World Cancer Day encourages involvement from various sectors, including health care workers, co-workers, leaders, caregivers, and

friends. The focus on breast cancer delved into risk factors such as lifestyle choices, reproductive factors, family history, and aging, with prevention strategies ranging from screening and mammography to Chemo-prevention and Biological prevention.

Survival rates were highlighted, with Stage 1 boasting a survival rate exceeding 95%, gradually decreasing to 20% at Stage 4. The imperative task of eliminating cervical cancer was addressed through universal access to HPV vaccination, screening programs, timely and accurate diagnosis, quality treatment, palliative care, and survivorship support. Cervical cancer prevention methods were detailed, including regular check-ups, the HPV vaccine, and PAP smear tests.

The correlation between smoking and cancer was underscored, noting that smoking can cause 16 types of cancers, with 1 in 8 cancer deaths and 1 in 5 deaths overall being attributed to smoking. Other contributing factors like Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C, aflatoxins, hemochromatosis, anabolic steroids, and cirrhosis were mentioned, emphasizing that early detection saves lives.



In conclusion, Dr. Bilal's comprehensive presentation underscored the urgency of global collaboration in the fight against cancer. World Cancer Day serves as a crucial platform to educate and motivate



individuals from all walks of life to contribute to the prevention, early detection, and treatment of cancer. By uniting efforts, significant strides can be made in reducing the global burden of this disease.

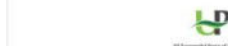

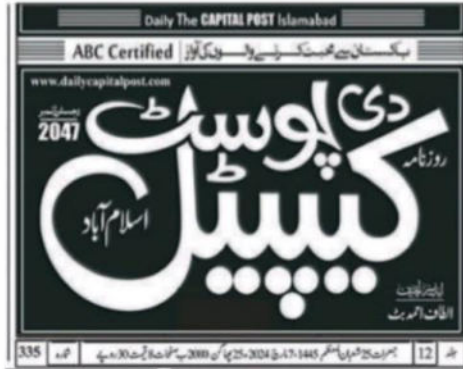
